

Collection Development Strategic Planning

Goal I. Purchase More E-Books in support of online programs.

- Objective 1. Analyze holdings with regard to online availability.
- Objective 2. Acquire books available as e-book on available platform.
- Objective 3. Create new workflow for Midwest orders to acquire e-books ordered via Midwest, but available online via YBP's Gobi3.

Goal II. Digitize Theses and make them available in digital format.

- Objective 1. Consult with Dean C on politics regarding digitization of theses.
- Objective 2. Consult with Grad Studies and COE for the thesis process.
- Objective 3. Consult with other CSUs who digitize theses for their process.
- Objective 4. Create flowchart of theses process as it stands currently.
- Objective 5. Consult with Head, LIT and Head Cataloger for technology and process for digitized theses.
- Objective 6. Create flowchart of proposed thesis process incorporating other campus units processes.
- Objective 7. Consult with all for buy-in to new procedure.
- Objective 8. Implement new process.

Goal III. Conduct library-wide weeding to free up shelf space and reduce impaction.

- Objective 1. Solidify library-wide collection development policy.
- Objective 2. Draft collection weeding policies.
- Objective 3. Consult with key stakeholders about weeding plans.
- Objective 4. Finish journal weeding.
- Objective 5. Draft plan for library-wide weeding of monographs and periodicals.

Goal IV. Establish a textbook collection in support of the "Affordable Education Initiative."

Objective 1. Analyze textbook holdings.

Objective 2. Acquire expensive books that many students may not be able to afford and make them available in the Reserves Unit.

Objective 3. Pilot test the use of pre-loaded textbooks in mobile devices that students can check out.

Objective 4. Review and revise Reserve late fees in order to encourage prompt return of materials for sharing with other patrons.
